

Health and Safety during COVID-19

Please Read! For the safety of our Customers, our Staff, and Coal Harbour Marina, we will be following the required re-opening and operating safety guidelines stated by Work Safe BC.

The virus that causes Covid-19 spreads in several ways. It can spread in droplets when a person coughs or sneezes. It can also spread if you touch a contaminated surface, then touch your face.

- We will allow up to 1 reserved rental group of up to 6 people at a time on the dock to enforce physical distancing protocol in the Marina. Groups who live together or groups who agree they are safe together may rent a boat together.
- Boat rentals are limited to advance phone and email reservations only, so that we can prevent unsafe overcrowding on the dock. We will try and accommodate walk-by business if we are able to safely fit you in between reserved times, but this must be arranged by phone (604) 682-6257. Please do not come to the dock until we call you when your reserved boat is ready.
- All people participating in the rental "bubble group", must not have symptoms of Covid-19 such as fever, coughing or difficulty breathing, and have not been in contact with people with Covid -19 in the last 10 days, or have been advised by health officials to quarantine, or have arrived from a foreign country and have not quarantined for the required 14 days. A participant may be asked to leave by our staff if they appear unwell.
- All vessel interiors and lifejackets will be sanitized prior to each use and a plexiglass shield is in place and regularly cleaned in our office. Hand Sanitizer is available for group use.
- A 2-hour minimum is in effect for our boat rentals. Please ensure you are ready at the top of the ramp, 20 minutes prior to reservation time to complete the required steps to rent a boat.
- All Staff have been trained in and shall follow our safety guidelines.
